

IOWA

Iowa (one of the rectangular states out in the middle of the country) currently has two state-run ICFs. Glenwood (GRC) is located in the southwest corner of the state on the Iowa/Nebraska border. Woodward (WRC) is located in the center of the state, near the capital, Des Moines.

Census:

WRC – today 153. Last June: 157

GRC: today – 238. Last June: 248

Waiver homes:

WRC: 12 homes serving 40 individuals.

GRC: 5 homes serving 19 individuals.

Both GRC and WRC have a goal to reduce our census by 12 each fiscal year. Our success in doing so depends on several factors, including community capacity, guardian approval, etc.

GRC did admit several clients from Park Place and we hired several of their direct care staff. (Park Place was a private ICF that closed because it wasn't making a profit.)

GRC has started a new client program within the past month – we developed a can redemption center after Park Place closed theirs.

GRC received major maintenance funding for several construction projects this year, including the replacement of our HVAC system and roof in the pool and upgrading plumbing in Lacey.
